**Olde Towne Neighborhood Watch**

At our January meeting, Dr. Pam Deering, Superintendent of Mid-Del Schools, explained the issues on the February 11 Bond Election.

The new police cars have arrived. It was also reported that in January, there were 14 burglaries in Del City. Nationwide, there is a burglary every 1½ to 2 minutes.

The new Fire Station will be constructed at the location of the old police station. This will take the place of the one on SE 44<sup>th</sup>. The Fire Station on SE 15<sup>th</sup> will remain. The new building on SE 15<sup>th</sup> & Vickie will be an Eye Doctor Office. Harbor Freight is going in next to Gold's Gym on SE 15<sup>th</sup>. A new storage facility is being build on SE 29<sup>th</sup> just west of Sooner. More businesses are opening in the "Shoppes" area on Sooner.
