Beware of New Scam

Watch your credit card statement for evidence a credit card cloning. A cloned credit card is a copy of the credit card in your wallet. The cloned card is used to make purchases and charged to your account. It is a crime that is on the rise around the country. A recent victim in Oklahoma had his credit card in his possession, but somehow the scammer was able to get the information from the card, make a copy and charge purchases in northwest Oklahoma City. Sheriff's officials say the best way to protect yourself is to check your credit card or bank statements regularly to make sure there are no strange charges.

Residents of any Del City neighborhood may dump on any or all of the scheduled weekends. A Del City water bill is required. No tires or hazardous waste will be allowed.

We need "new blood". We can train you to patrol. If you are patrolling and see something suspicious, call the police. You do not make contact with any person. You just watch and report. Each group is responsible for one weekend a year.
