Geese Hunting at Eagle Lake

Eagle Lake will be closed September 12 - 21, to the public for the purpose of hunting Canadian Geese. For permits, please visit the permit desk at City Hall. The Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation will be in charge of the hunting period.

Law requires each waterfowl hunter 16 and older must carry a valid Migratory Bird Hunting & Conservation Stamp (federal duck stamp), signed in ink across the face. Hunters also must carry the HIP permit, unless exempt.

All hunters 16 and older must have in their possession proof of purchase of an Oklahoma waterfowl license or proof of exemption while hunting waterfowl.

All waterfowl and coot hunting is restricted to the use of federally approved nontoxic shot in all areas of the state. Possession of lead shot while hunting waterfowl or coots is prohibited.
